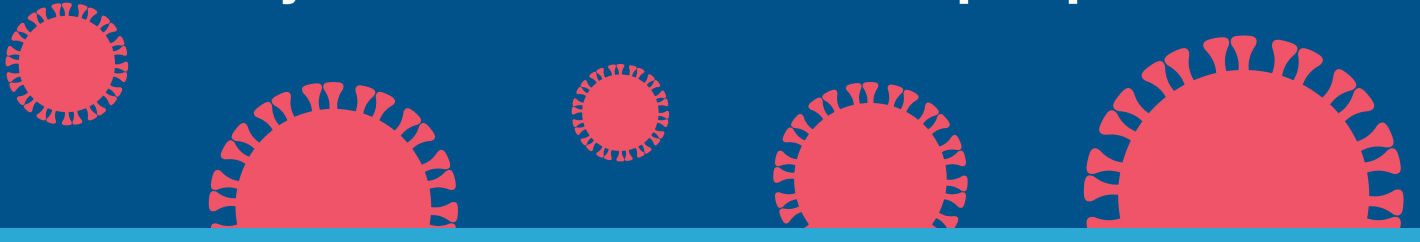


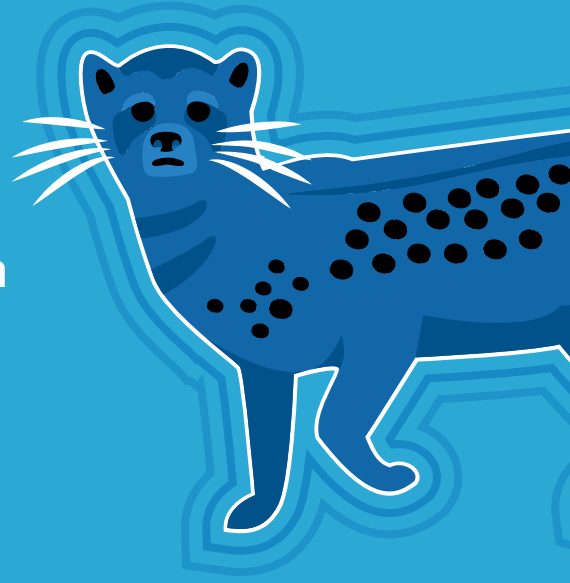
Coronaviruses

Coronaviruses are a broad family of viruses, only 7 are known to infect people



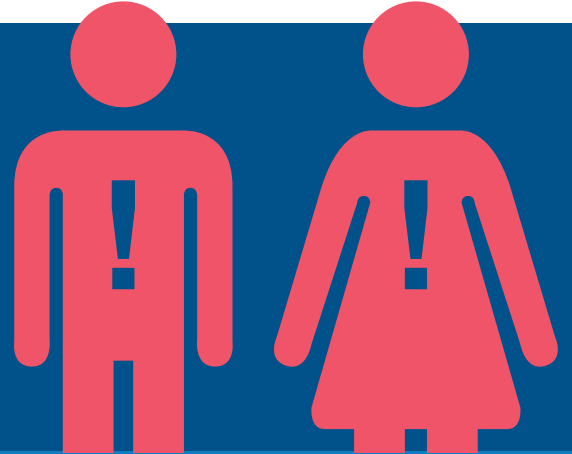
Coronaviruses have been passed to humans from animals

- MERS regularly makes the jump from the dromedary camel

Covid-19, as it has been formally named, is a new strain of coronavirus that has not previously been identified in humans

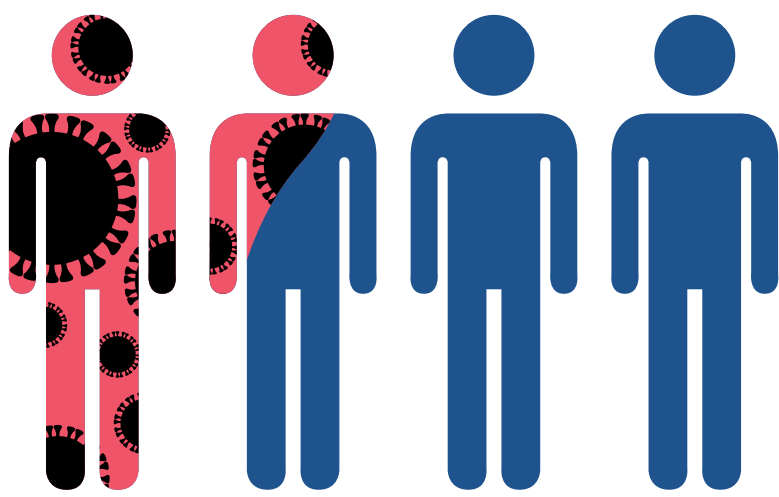
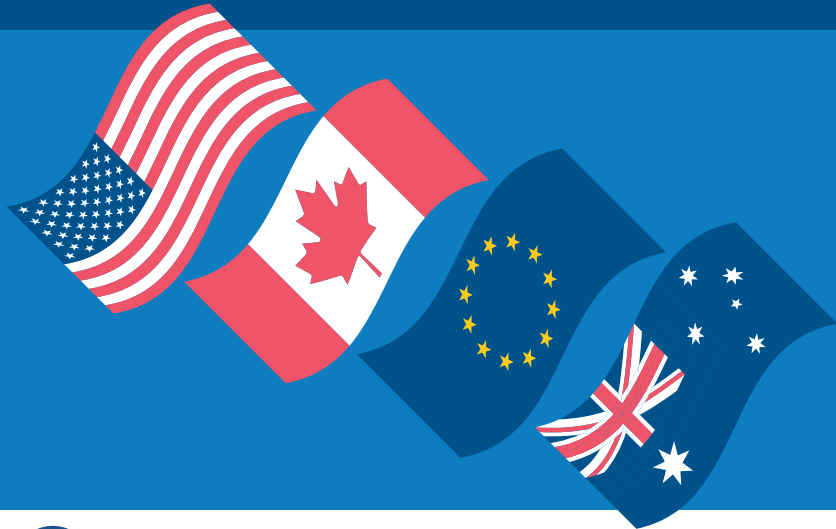


7th Jan - first case confirmed in Wuhan China

Within the 1st month, over 43,000 confirmed cases and over 1000 deaths
